(BIRCH STREET, FLEETWOOD, WYRE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council considers it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Birch Street, Fleetwood outside house number 31 for approximately 20 metres.
2. Nothing in this Notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 1025 hours on Wednesday 11th November 2020 until 1800 hours on Sunday 15th November 2020 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow immediate works to repair a defective sewer to be carried out by Sapphire Utility Solutions on behalf of United Utilities.
